- I. **Roll Call:** PPLAB members present: Shelly Alm, K. English Hopkins, Keaton Howe, Mark Newland, Billy O'Donnell, Ellen Toon. Guests: Lucia Harrop. Staff Liaison: Dean Johnson. City Council Liaison: Susan Loo. City Staff: Joe Stevens.
- II. **Approval of Agenda**

- IV. **Staff Updates:** November 15th is the deadline for applications from board members whose terms expire in December. English announced she will not be re-applying.

It was suggested that we have a ribbon cutting at the Arboretum once the restrooms are completed and a PPLAB meeting to be held there in the spring.

DBA previously ran floral and holiday lights but now that it's been turned over to the city, they were able to bid the work out cheaper and can now add extra city blocks.

- V. **Board Updates:** An update on the Mayhoffer property was given. There was discussion regarding city signage for gateways, but noted that these signs are very costly. The board is interested in keeping the discussion open for this

and it was recommended we present this to council during our study session.

- VI. **Public comments on Items Not on the Agenda:** A letter from Bev Snyder was read expressing her concern about the use of Glyphosate and 2-4-D in our parks. The City's goal is to limit exposure to the public.
- VII. **Discussion on Herbicide Use in Playgrounds:** Lucia has a petition with 330 signatures for no spraying with 2 chemicals. There is concern with the grass as well as sand being sprayed. She noted Boulder's promotion to the public of Healthier Parks = Healthier People. She noted the Pleasant View Fields an athletic field award they won with not using pesticides. It was suggested she check with CU and their possible organic weed control.

What council is looking to PPLAB for regarding use of herbicides is—what are the options? –what are the consequences? –what is the economic impact? If it is decided to review the Integrative Weed Management Program, then it would require OSAB as well. Joe Stevens will let us know of short term solutions that can be implemented with the focus on playgrounds first. There are 14 playgrounds in Louisville.
