A new program is available at your local library!

Junior **FIRST**® LEGO® League (Jr.FLL®) is designed for children ages 6-9 years old, and features a real-world scientific concept to be explored through research, teamwork, construction and imagination. Guided by Coaches, teams use LEGO elements to build a model that moves, experience the engineering design process, and develop a *Show Me* poster to illustrate their journey.

This library program is a collaboration between Jr.FLL and **STAR_Library Education Network (STAR_Net)**. Jr.FLL is a program of *FIRST* (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology). STAR_Net is a production of the National Center for Interactive Learning at the Space Science Institute.

Coach Responsibilities

Anyone can help! You do not need a technical background to be a Coach – just a willingness to learn with the kids.

- Lead Coaches must be 18 years or older.
- Guides teams of two to six children, 6-9 years old, through the season (assisting with research and team management).
- Facilitates discussion.
- Helps children problem solve along the way.
- Organizes weekly meetings for 1-2 hours once or twice a week for 6-8 weeks.
- Follows the Challenge directions.
