Library Expands “Have It Today” Collection to Include DVDs

Latest DVDs Available on First-Come, First-Served Basis

LOUISVILLE, CO – April 9, 2010 – To wrap up National Library Week on April 17, the Louisville Library will unveil its latest special collection—Have It Today (HIT) DVDs. The collection will feature copies of the latest releases and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Like all the Library’s DVDs, a HIT DVD can be borrowed for one week.

What’s different? A HIT DVD can’t be placed on hold, and it can’t be renewed. The purpose is to help make new titles available to more borrowers more quickly. The HIT DVDs will be on display on a kiosk in the Lobby, so patrons can just pop in, make a selection, and even use one of three self-check stations to checkout the DVD.
