

‘On The Same Page’ Announces *The Night Circus* as the Choice for the 2013 One-book Program

Lafayette, Louisville & Superior Unite for the 3rd Annual Community Reading Event

LOUISVILLE, CO — June 24, 2013 — On Friday evening, June 21, 2013, amid the fun and festivities of Art Night Out in Lafayette’s Festival Plaza, *The Night Circus* was revealed by local magician Dave Elstun as the title for the 3rd annual ‘On The Same Page’ (OTSP) community one-book program. This was quite fitting because *The Night Circus*, author Erin Morgenstern’s debut novel, is a fantastical tale of two magicians locked in a spellbinding dual. With funds donated by the Lafayette and Louisville library foundations and the Town of Superior, the Lafayette and Louisville libraries have purchased more than 100 paperback copies of the book, along with audio, e-book, and Spanish language versions. Beginning in September, ‘On The Same Page’ will offer book discussions and a variety of programs that echo the themes in this year’s title, such as aerial artists, ‘Stories on Stage’, and magic performances.
