Louisville Library Now Offering eBooks for the Kindle® eBooks Available Through the Library's Digital Content Provider, OverDrive

LOUISVILLE, CO – September 23, 2011 – If you have a Kindle and have been waiting to check out Library eBooks, your wait is officially over. On September 21, Amazon® announced its highly anticipated move to offer Kindle and Kindle app customers the ability to borrow Kindle books through more than 11,000 public libraries in the United States.

How does this work for Louisville Library patrons? Simply visit the Library's home page and find the section on eBooks and digital content from OverDrive®, the Library's digital content provider. Follow the easy steps to add an eBook title to your cart and then check out for download. When you choose a Kindle version of an eBook, you will see "Get for Kindle" on the download screen. From there, users will be redirected to Amazon and a series of simple steps to complete the download to a Kindle. Right now, about 90% of the Library's eBook titles are available in the Kindle format. To help Kindle users through this process, the Library home page also has a link to a video tutorial provided by OverDrive, "How to get library eBooks on the Amazon® Kindle."
