

2017 UTILITY RATE INCREASES

NEW WASTEWATER AND STORMWATER RATES

City Council recently approved rate increases for wastewater and stormwater utility service. The new rates are necessary to fund major reconstruction projects, ensure the City can properly maintain these utility systems, meet all Federal and State clean water regulations, and collect sufficient revenue to cover operations, maintenance, debt obligations, and improvement expenses for each service. WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR MY UTILITY BILL?

The new rates will be effective in May and you will see an increase in your utility bill starting in June. The table below reflects the anticipated monthly impact for a typical residential customer. The impact on your bill may be more or less depending on how much water you use.
