If I didn't comment on a specific location, with all due respect, it is because I don't think it is a good location. Thank you for allowing one citizen's input as follows:

John Breaux Park:

1. why confuse this existing park with another subject? John was an exemplary citizen, and I believe putting a cabin here confuses the intent of the park.
2. This Park is fine and respectably simple as is, ("Less is More".)
3. Why waste funds in redesign and reconstructing what already is fine as is?
4. it seems the cabins should be together, to maintain the character of a couple of Miners coming home from work, i.e.; neighbors, in their familiar perhaps humble but proud neighborhood.

South Main Street:

1. This neighborhood is out of context with the history of the Cabins' original domicile.
2. Cutting down another tree is just the opposite of what the City should be doing.
3. The idea of a vest pocket park here is interesting, and keeping it for the citizen's use someday is better than giving it to someone, but putting a Cabin in here to drive a park seems ambiguous or confused.

Nawatny Greenway:

1. If this location has no historic cabin theme, why place the Historic Cabins here?
2. It seems the N. Green can stand on it's own.

Miner's Field:

1. This locale seems the best to me. Perhaps a Miner or two played baseball at Miner's Field....and that conjures up some interesting History or heritage.
2. This location is very close to their original domicile.
3. Miner's field is a beautiful facility that many many people see as they drive south on Highway 42, have used themselves, and improving this location would benefit all who use it and further show the City's commitment to respecting Louisville's humble and gritty past.
