Information about transportation and RTD's Call-n-Ride service - Audrey DeBarros from Commuting Solutions visited the board to present about public transportation and the RTD call-and-ride service. She talked about how anyone can use the call-and-ride though simply arranging a trip in advance either online or by calling, as well as the different opportunities for public transportation available to students for transportation to and from school. With all the traffic during the beginning and end of school, there is a need for alternate transportation to help with rush hour. One solution could be education and outreach with incentives to boost youth usership of the call-and-ride.

Volunteer Projects

- **October**
 - **Updates from Bruce** – Bruce presented a volunteer idea through *A Precious Child* where the board members would assist in a winter clothing drive by collecting donations around the town.  - **Updates from Addie** – Addie talked about *There With Care* which is an organization that helps families and children facing critical illnesses. Possible volunteer projects include putting together gifts, making blankets, bringing children food, and visiting kids in the hospital.
 - Jessica presented an idea for a volunteer project where the board would work with *Passing Hats* to make hats for people going through chemotherapy.

Ideas for new Rec Center programs – Ideas that were suggested include: a kahoot quiz game competition, a monthly movie night, crafting/tie-dyeing, origami, bath bomb making, quizlet live competition, water polo, yoga classes, water volleyball, life-coaching classes, college application classes, money finance classes.

Year-Long Project – The board discussed the two ideas for the board's year-long project. The first idea is a transportation project and the second is a new Dear Louisville book.
