

‘On The Same Page’ Announces Title for 2016 One-book Program

***All the Light We Cannot See* by Anthony Doerr
Winner of the 2015 Pulitzer Prize for Fiction**

Lafayette, Louisville & Superior Unite for the 6th Annual Community Reading Event

LOUISVILLE, CO — June 15, 2016 — For the sixth year in a row, the communities of Lafayette, Louisville, and Superior have joined to present ‘On The Same Page,’ a one-book event that asks everyone to read the same book at the same time.



This year’s title, by Anthony Doerr, is an epic novel of historical fiction that takes place in the seaside enclave of Saint-Malo, France, during the final days of World War II. As noted on the Pulitzer website, the book is “An imaginative and intricate novel inspired by the horrors of World War II and written in short, elegant chapters that explore human nature and the contradictory power of technology.”

With funds donated by the Lafayette and Louisville library foundations and the Town of Superior, the Lafayette and Louisville libraries have purchased more than 100 copies of the book. Book club sets with multiple copies of the title are also available through both libraries. The title will also be available on CD, as a downloadable e-book, in large print, and in Spanish.

Beginning in September, ‘On The Same Page’ will offer book discussions and its perennially popular ‘Stories on Stage’ performance at the Louisville Center for the Arts sponsored by the Louisville Cultural Council.
