### Teen Services Department:

- Teen Advisory Group
  - Meet on the 2nd Tuesday of each month from 5-6pm to plan library programs and events, recommend books for the collection, offer opinions on policies, and more.
- Study Buddies (for high school students only)
  - Provide drop in homework help for kids in grades 4-8.
- Tutoring (for high school students only)
  - Meet with a middle school student every week for one hour throughout the semester.
- Review Crew
  - Write book reviews for the library's teen book review blog.

### Makerspace:

- Makerspace Program Assistant
  - Greet Makerspace guests, answer questions about use of space, and provide assistance as needed. Collaborate with staff & volunteers developing maker programs and organizing required materials and resources.
- Makerspace Maintenance
  - Restock Makerspace supplies, make sure the space is clean and organized, and ensure that everything is in working order.



**Children’s Department:**

- Reading Buddies
  - Read one-on-one with a child in grades K-2 for an hour each week to help foster a love of reading.
- Teen Summer Squad (\*opportunity only available during the summer)
  - Help out in the Children’s Room during the Summer Reading Program by staffing the summer reading check-in station and helping out with various tasks around the department.
- Children’s Project Aide
  - Help the Children’s Division with one of our current projects or come in to clean books. Shifts are a maximum 2.0 hours long.
- Children’s Division Aide
  - Help the Children’s Division with various tasks throughout the department such as prepping crafts, filling displays, and tidying up. Shifts are a maximum 2.0 hours long, scheduled once a week, for a full semester.
