Call to Order – Chairperson Norgard called the meeting to order at 6:35.

Approval of Agenda – The agenda was approved, with one change in the order to allow public speakers to voice their views on the topic of swimming pool use.

Second: Van Pelt

The motion passed 6-1, with Bradfield voting against.

Approval of Meeting Minutes – The minutes from the July 22, 2019 meeting were approved as written.

Motion: Kutscher

Second: Norgard

Public Comments – Multiple speakers voiced their wish to revisit the Recreation Center Pool's hours and lane use allocations for the Monarch High School swim teams. The hours and allocations had been recommended by staff and then supported by the Recreation Advisory Board after the public comments and meeting last month. Nathan Mosely summarized the current early morning pool schedule. Monarch High School Principal, Neil Anderson, stated the

Administration's request for time usage, which was 6-7:30a.m., using all 6 lanes of the main pool, but stated that the request was flexible. Several parents and swim team members voiced opinions that differed from the school's time requests, and from each other. Gene Kutscher pointed out that letters received by the Recreation Advisory Board and the staff cited safety, but were in conflict with each other regarding which times were safer for the students. He noted that ultimately the pool staff, school, students and parents need to plan for safety regardless of the final schedule. Lisa Norgard thanked everyone for their input.

City Council Update

There was no update at this meeting.

Golf Course Strategic Plan, Staffing and Dashboard

Dashboards

- Nathan Mosely presented the newest format for the Dashboards, which was received very positively.

Golf Course Strategic Plan

- Nathan Mosely distributed The Coal Creek Golf Course Operational Work Plan, which was reviewed. He noted that capital proposals are receiving ongoing attention. In response to a question, he added that a new area for chemical storage is in the capital budget proposal, and there is money to analyze the adequacy of the golf clubhouse.

Recreation Staff and Construction Update

Staff Update

- Based on the earlier discussions, a motion was made to support the idea of keeping the Monarch High School swim team hours as 6:30-7:45 a.m., but to add a fifth dedicated lane out of the 6 for them in the lap pool, plus keep a dedicated lane for them at that time in the smaller pool.

The motion passed 6-1 with Van Pelt opposed

- After discussion, The Recreation Advisory Board felt it is important to develop a Priority of Use Document for the Recreation Center facilities as a recommendation guideline for staff. A working committee will be formed to commence this process.

Programming, Punch List and VE

- Kathy Martin updated investigations into the cost and uses for a Recreation Center app.
- Kathy Martin also reported on the latest punch list. She noted the list is much smaller and progress is being made.
- Nathan Mosely presented the proposed fee structure for the Recreation and Senior Center for the 2020 calendar year.

Outdoor Recreation Amenities Subcommittee Report

- Gene Kutscher reported that there is a draft community survey designed to see what outdoor recreation facilities are used by Louisville residents, and where they see adequacy and deficits. Recreation Advisory Board members were asked to take the proposed survey and recommended changes. The hope is for the finalized survey to go out shortly. He also noted that each member of the subcommittee will contact two relevant communities to examine what facilities and usage they have.




Estimated Reserve Balance







Purpose:

The purpose of this agenda item is to share the preliminary survey results with the RAB.

Background:


A sub-committee of the RAB and the Parks and Public Landscaping boards was formed to evaluate outdoor athletic amenities within the City. The board has been meeting and developed a public input survey, is benchmarking with other municipalities in Colorado and also with the National Recreation and Parks Association. The information gathered will help to inform the master planning that will be taking place for Cottonwood Park in 2020 and the Recreation Center campus in following years. This information could also inform development processes citywide and what types of athletic amenities might be appropriate. Finally, the information can be used to aid in the development of Capital Improvement Plan requests for the next budget cycle beginning in 2020.

Next Steps:

The sub-committee will meet to discuss results of the survey and benchmarking and determine next steps.





Q8 What is your Gender?



Q9 What is your age?



Q10 Number of years Lived in Louisville?





Subject: United Health Care Renew Active and Silver Sneakers Programs

Purpose:

The purpose of this agenda item is to get feedback from the RAB on implementing a new United Health Care Renew Active program and to give an update on the Silver Sneakers and Silver & Fit programs participation and contract renewal.

Background:

The Louisville Recreation and Senior Center currently accepts both SilverSneakers and Silver & Fit programs.

Silver Sneakers and Silver & Fit are programs modeled for older adults that have either program as a benefit on their supplemental Medicare Plans (age 65+). Both programs encourage older adults to participate in physical activities that will in turn, help them to maintain greater control of their health and longevity. The programs help older adults stay strong in body, mind, and spirit. Regular physical activity helps keep the heart, brain, bones, muscles, and joints healthy. Plus, staying social is vital to good health.

The Silver Sneakers program began at the Recreation & Senior Center in 2007. In 2007 the center had 14,717 Silver Sneakers visits during the first full year and now, 12 years later the center is on track to see over 70,000 visits in 2019.

According to the August 2019 Utilization report, we currently have 1,925 members enrolled and an average of 948 active participants. The retention rate at the Louisville Recreation & Senior Center is 54% and is higher than other local recreation centers (the average is 30-40% elsewhere).

The Silver Sneakers August Utilization shows 948 active members with a total of 4,893 visits for that month. Our payment for August was \$13,716.30 and our average for a 12 month period per month is \$14,189. To date for 2019, we have received \$129,149.00.

Staff is currently negotiating an increased reimbursement rate with Tivity for SilverSneakers that would go into effect January 2020.

The center is required to offer 2 Silver Sneaker classes at the center to be recognized as a Silver Sneakers facility. The fitness instructors who teach those classes must be Silver Sneakers certified and we must use Silver Sneaker equipment in those classes. Silver Sneaker instructors are paid, variable salary employees of the City. An equipment fund of \$250.00/year is given to Silver Sneaker facilities to offset the cost of weights, bands, balls and other equipment for classes.

Currently, one of the insurance companies that offers plans with Silver Sneakers is United Health Care (UHC). Beginning in January 2020, UHC will no longer offer Silver Sneakers. Instead, they are starting their own fitness incentive program called Renew Active. We are currently corresponding with a representative from Renew Active and gathering information to determine whether to participate in the program. Of the approximately 948 active SilverSneakers members, 269 have UHC plans.

Beginning in October UHC communicated information about the change to their members and staff has fielded 35 inquiries to date with the question of if the Recreation and Senior Center is going to offer Renew Active. Due to the requests staff has begun negotiations with UHC on a reimbursement rate and contract. Open enrollment for participants ends December 7.

There are currently 37 fitness centers that will be offering Renew Active within a 10 mile radius of Louisville including Bob L. Burger Recreation Center, Boulder Recreation Centers, Paul Derda Recreation Center, the Lafayette and Mapleton YMCA, and the Erie Community Center.

In addition to Silver Sneakers, the Recreation & Senior Center has Silver and Fit, which is a program similar to SilverSneakers that some other insurance companies offer. It is much smaller in scale with a total of 66 visits for August 2019 and 8 active members. Our August payment from Silver & Fit was \$70.00. Silver Sneakers also has a program called PRIME that we are members of but have very little participation at this time. Union Pacific Railroad offered a similar program which was accepted as a trial plan for 2 years. There were only 9 active members in that program and there was a cost to be associated with the program, so the decision was made to terminate that agreement October 1, 2019.

Next Steps:

Staff will continue to work to renew the contract with SS at a higher reimbursement rate that will go into effect in January 2020. This contract could be a multi- year contract with the same rate for multiple years.

With feedback from RAB, staff will initiate a contract with UHC for the Renew Active program beginning in January 2020 if that is the decision that is supported.
