III. Coyote Interactions with Humans

Observation: The act of noticing or taking note of tracks, den, scat or vocalizations.

Sighting: Visual observation of coyote from a distance greater than 100 feet.

Encounter: An unexpected direct meeting, within 100 feet, that is without incident. Coming within close proximity of a coyote on a trail, sidewalk, street or yard.

Incident: A conflict between a human and a coyote where a coyote exhibits behavior that creates an unsafe situation (stalking, baring teeth, chasing humans).

Attack: An aggressive interaction where a human is grabbed, bitten, scratched, or bodily injured.
